

New Appointments and Developments for AA Projects

New Strategic Management, Project Management and Quantity Surveying Appointments

The Strategic Management team has been commissioned to undertake feasibility studies at Lakes College in Cumbria and Hopwood Hall College Heywood Skills Centre. Space planning for a new college feasibility study is being provided for Tamworth and Litchfield College.

Dudley College has commissioned the Birmingham office Project Management team to undertake a feasibility study for their campus relocation/rationalisation, an estimated £100 million development.

Barnsley College has appointed the Project Management and Quantity Surveying teams on a £50 million project involving the construction of a new 8 storey college building and the demolition of existing college premises.

The Newcastle Project Management team is working with the University of Northumbria City Campus on the refurbishment of two floors in the existing Squires Building.

The Birmingham office is providing monitoring services on a number of schemes at different stages of completion on behalf of the Heritage Lottery Fund.

The Project Management team has been appointed by Blackpool Sixth Form College to continue to provide services from Stage D onwards.

The Quantity Surveying division is providing Employer's Agent services for Warwickshire Police Authority for the construction of a new 5 storey Justice Centre building including car parking, custody suite and associated offices. Construction value approximately £26.5 million.

The Project Management and Strategic Management teams are providing services for Tyne & Wear Autistic Society in respect of their provision for new learning facilities at North Hylton, Sunderland and fitting out of existing office buildings.

The Health & Safety team is providing fire risk assessments at Xaverian College and Mid Cheshire College. They are also providing CDM guidance at Northumbria University to create a main entrance to the School of Arts centre. The entrance will also provide a separate gallery space, office, CPD suite and Well Being Centre.
