

New Appointments and Developments for AA Projects

New Strategic Management, Project Management, Quantity Surveying and CDM-Coordinator Appointments

AA Projects has been appointed at King George V College to undertake Strategic Management, Project Management, Quantity Surveying and CDM-Coordinator services as part of their Estate Rationalisation and Renewal. The project has an estimated value of £42m.
