

## New Appointments and Developments for AA Projects

### **New Strategic Management, Project Management and Quantity Surveying Appointments**

The Strategic Management team has been commissioned to undertake the property strategy and feasibility study for the proposed merger of Salford Colleges (Pendleton, Eccles and Salford Colleges), to create the new Salford City College. Other commissions awarded this month were for feasibility studies at Leeds College of Building and the University of Cumbria, Newton Rigg Campus.

The Strategic Management team has also been commissioned to develop a response to Suffolk Learning & Skills Council's statement of need for a 16-19 competition in Lowestoft on behalf of the Sixth Form College's Forum and at Leeds College of Building the Strategic Management team has been commissioned to provide a property strategy.

At Liverpool John Moores University, AA Projects has been commissioned for Project Management services on their Mount Pleasant Campus Redevelopment and at John Leggott College in Scunthorpe Project Management services are also being provided on a new build project. At St John Rigby College, Strategic Management, Project Management and CDM-C services are being provided on a New Campus Development and at the Tyne & Wear Autistic Society Project Management and Quantity Surveying services have been commissioned on a new school.

Following a successful tender process, AA Projects has been awarded Project Management services at Hopwood Hall College for their estate redevelopment and at Cardinal Newman College, AA Projects has been commissioned by Cardinal Newman College to provide Project Management and Quantity Surveying services on their Phase 5 feasibility study.

Following another successful tender process, AA Projects is to provide Project Management, Quantity Surveying and Building Surveying services for Green Spaces

for People, which is a programme to provide hard and soft landscaping works in social housing sites around the country.

The Project Management and Quantity Surveying division are developing a feasibility cost plan for the proposed refurbishment and alteration of offices at an existing call centre facility in Leicester for Centrica plc.

The Health & Safety team has been appointed to provide CDM-C sub-consultancy service to Smith Smalley Architects for AMOC Amalgamated construction Ltd, at EDF Energy, Cottam Power Station and are also producing an asbestos management plan for Barrow Sixth Form College and providing CDM services on the demolition of a single storey plumbing workshop at North Lindsey College.
